



HOME IGNITION ZONE CHECKLIST

IMMEDIATE ZONE (0–5 FEET)

Create a non-combustible zone within 5 feet of your home.

- ✓ Remove all combustible materials within 5 feet of your home.
- ✓ Keep roofs and gutters clear of leaves and pine needles.
- ✓ Keep plants healthy, well-watered and properly maintained.



IMPORTANT REMINDERS



If you are evacuated, turn off your propane.



Know how to shut off your propane supply.



Have a hose in the front and back of your home.

INTERMEDIATE ZONE (5–30 FEET)

Reduce wildfire fuels and create defensible space.

- ✓ Clear vegetation and debris.
- ✓ Space trees and shrubs to reduce fire intensity.
- ✓ Prune tree branches up to 10 feet from the ground.
- ✓ Remove dead plants, fallen branches and dry grass.



STATIONARY PROPANE TANKS

Keep area around tanks:

- ✓ Clear of vegetation and debris.
- ✓ Free of overhanging branches.
- ✓ Accessible for emergency responders.

ADDITIONAL FIREWISE TIPS



Use fire-resistant plants and low-flammability landscaping.



Store firewood at least 30 feet away from your home.



Sweep decks, patios and driveways regularly.
