Survey Results on Tonto Hills Road Conditions

The Tonto Hills Improvement Association received a significant number of responses to the 2015 road survey. Sixty-four (64) of the one hundred and ninety-one (191) members of the Association responded. The following shows the break down of the three questions. That is a response rate of just over 33%. Typically, a survey that receives more than 25% is considered to be a valid data sample of the whole.

Two responses stated no opinion on conditions or remedies, just not willing to pay for paving. The 62 responses break down as follows:

1. How would you rate the condition of the roads in Tonto Hills?

Good	<u>21%</u>
Fair	<u>52%</u>
Poor	<u>27%</u>

Most common comments: Dust and washboard problems

2. What improvements would you like to see? (Chip seal is not a viable option.)

Pave	<u>50%</u>
Dust palliative	<u>24%</u>
Leave the road surface as is	<u>26%</u>
Other	<u>0%</u>

Most common comments: Paving is best solution

3. If roads were paved and lot owners are assessed for some or all the cost, do you still prefer paving?

Yes	<u>44%</u>
No	<u>56%</u>

Most common comments: We won't pay
